
The King's Beard


One day the king wanted to test his ministers. So he called them all and asked a simple question, "What should you do to the person who pulls a king's beard?"




The young ministers pulled out their swords and shouted, "We will kill the person who dares to pull the king's beard."




There was one old and wise minister, who softly said, "We must salute the person who pulls our King's beard."




Everybody was taken aback.
